NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES CLOSE at the Show Secretary's office (Terese Barta, 2409 Stanley St. Stevens Point, WI 54481-9205) Wednesday, January 7, 2004 at 3:00 PM, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in the AKC *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, Chapter 11. ENTRIES MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted.

MAKE CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS payable to: TRACCW. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. MAIL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO Terese Barta, Event Secretary 2409 Stanley St., Stevens Point. FAX MACHINE ENTRIES FOR THIS SHOW WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & JUDGING PROGRAM will be sent (via First Class USPS mail) to the address on the Official AKC entry form, as soon as possible after the closing date . . . as per AKC *Rules and Regulations*.

BITCHES IN SEASON (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete. If a bitch entered in the show is proven to be in season on the date of the show. A full refund less \$1.00 of the entry fee will be made by the show giving club to the owner of the bitch.

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, Chapter 11, Section 2).

RETURNED CHECKS AND DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify Terese Barta, Event Secretary, 715-342-1764.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made at the awards table upon the completion of the judging, and the Trial Secretary will be advised at once. The Show-giving Club and Show Secretary may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after all judging has been completed.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SHOW SECRETARY will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show . . . If not, they become the property of the TRACCW. NO TROPHIES will be mailed. TRACCW RESERVES THE RIGHT to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

PLEASE NOTE: This is a new route off of Hwy 10. The old turnoff, Lake Road, has been closed permanently. A new Hwy 10 bypass is under construction near Camp Bandy. While no detours are expected, we will do our best to have the most current information possible included with your confirmation letter.

From North, South and West: I-39 to Hwy.10 East (towards Waupaca) approximately 10 miles to County Road Q in Amherst Junction. Turn Right on County Road Q. Turn Right at stop sign onto Main Street. Stay to Right at fork in the road. Camp Bandy is on the Right just out of town (approximately 3 blocks).

From East: Hwy.10 West to Amherst (approximately 10 miles from Waupaca). Approx. two miles west of Amherst, watch for the intersection of Hwy 10 and Hwy 161/County Road Q. Turn Left on County Road Q in Amherst Junction. Turn Right at stop sign onto Main Street. Stay to Right at fork in the road. Camp Bandy is on the Right just out of town (approximately 3 blocks).

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
