Obedience entries are limited to **55 dogs** per trial, according to UKC regulations. Agility entries are limited to **200 dogs** per day. Prizes awarded to first place in each class.

Entry Fees

Agility

Pre-entries: \$18 1st entry, \$12 additional entry same dog, same trial.

Example 1: *Dogs entered in 2 classes in the same trial (AGII & AGIII or AGI & AGII in trial #1) Entry fee = \$30.*

Example 2: *Dogs entered in 1 class in both trials (AGI in Trial #1 & #2) Entry fee = \$36*

DOS entries: \$20 1st entry, \$15 additional entry same dog, same trial.

Obedience

Pre-entries: \$18 1st entry, \$12 additional entry same dog.

Example 1: *Dog entered in Open & Utility Trial #1 entry fee = \$30*

Example 2: *Dog entered in Novice in Trial #1 & #2 entry fee = \$36*

DOS entries: \$20 1st entry, \$15 additional entry same dog.

Non-licensed: \$10 per entry

Pre-entries close February 18, 2007 or when limit is reached.

Express mail entries must be marked no receipt signature required.

There will be no refund after the advanced entry deadline.

Class Information

Agility I Class (UAGI): Agility I is considered the entry level class. Agility I is split into A and B sections. The Agility I-A class (AGI-A) will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGI title. The Agility I-B class (AGI-B) will be open to all dogs.

Agility II Class (UAGII): Entry in this class does not require the previous attainment of the Agility I title. A dog may be entered in both Agility I and Agility II at the same trial before or after the UAG I title has been awarded. The Agility II class is split into A and B sections. Agility II-A class (AGII-A) will be open to dogs that have not earned a U.K.C. UAGII title. The Agility II-B (AGII-B) will be open to all dogs.

Agility Champion (UACH): This title is awarded on the basis of 100 UACH points accumulated from the Agility I and Agility II classes for scores of 196 to 200. All points toward the United Agility Champion title (UACH) must be earned from the Agility I-B and Agility II-B classes. At least 40 of the points must be obtained from the Agility II-B class.

Score of 200 = 10 UACH points

Score of 199 = 6 UACH points

Score of 198 = 4 UACH points

Score of 197 = 2 UACH points

Score of 196 = 1 UACH points

Agility III Class (UACHX): Entry in Agility III requires the completion of the Agility Champion Title.

Division Information

Division 1: Shoulder height up to and including 14 inches. Hurdle height, 8 inches.

Division 2: Shoulder height over 14 inches and up to and including 20 inches. Hurdle height, 14 inches.

Division 3: Shoulder height over 20 inches. Hurdle height, 20 inches.

HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com. TL numbers are valid for 60 days*. (Fees are non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.) *Call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020 for current fee.
- Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified.
- Obedience Trials, Agility Trials, Weight Pull events and Dog Sport Trial events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.
- Obedience only: Check the box provided to request either the Veteran or Special Jump height option. Veteran dogs must be 8 years or older. Eligible dogs for Special Jump Heights are outlined in the current rules and regulations.
- Conformation classes consist of: Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Senior (2 yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. and up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.
- Junior Showmanship classes consist of: Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)

We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. *Important things to remember.*

- All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number for performance events.
- All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister.

WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or firearms will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event. UKC, its agents and employees, and the host club assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC and the host club are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.

By signing this form, I hereby agree to waive any claim, action, or lawsuit and further agree to indemnify and hold UKC, the host club and any approved UKC Judge harmless from any claims, actions or lawsuits resulting from my participation in this event, and any action, decision or judgment made by any UKC or host club representative or approved Judge under the official UKC Rules and Regulations governing this event. I acknowledge that the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations (Agility, Conformation, Dog Sport, Junior Showmanship, Obedience, Terrier Race, Weight Pull) have been made available to me, and that I am familiar with their contents.
